Ribbon	Criteria
N-1-1 Distinguished Cadet	Awarded annually to a cadet who exhibits the highest degree of excellence in scholastics/outstanding academic performance (LET 3, Junior, Highest GPA in Battalion.)
N-1-2 Academic Excellence	Awarded annually to one cadet in each LET level for maintaining highest school academic grades (highest GPA).
N-1-3 Academic Achievement	Awarded annually to those cadets who maintain a grade of an "A" or a "4.0" GPA in all academic classes for the entire year (two semesters/4 quarters).
N-1-4 Perfect Attendance	Awarded to cadets with no unexcused absences during each quarter/semester.
N-1-5 Student Government	Awarded to cadets who are officers of the student government.
N-1-6 Let Service	Awarded to cadets who successfully complete the first semester of JROTC training each year. (Lamps awarded respectively)
N-1-7 SAT/ACT Award	Awarded to cadets that receive 1250 or higher on the SAT and/or a 24 or higher on the ACT.
N-1-8 Academic Performance	Awarded annually to those cadets who maintain a "B" or "3.0" GPA in all classes for the entire year (two semesters/4 quarters).
N-1-9 NCO of the Month	Awarded to cadets who have won an NCO of the Month board during one of the given months out of the school year.

<p>N-1-10 Academic Competition Ribbon</p>	<p>Awarded annually to those cadets who have competed on the JLAB Academic Team respectively.</p>
<p>N-2-1 Varsity Sports</p>	<p>Awarded annually to cadets who have participated in a varsity sport.</p>
<p>N-2-2 Physical Fitness</p>	<p>Awarded annually to those cadets who complete the mile, during Cadet Challenge in under the allotted time. (8:30 for males and 10:45 for females)</p>
<p>N-2-3 ROTC Athletics</p>	<p>Awarded annually to cadets who excel in ROTC athletics. (Ex: National in Cadet Challenge)</p>
<p>N-2-4 Marching Band</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets who participate in the Marching Band.</p>
<p>N-2-5 JV Athletic Ribbon</p>	<p>Awarded to any cadet who has participated in a complete season of a JV sport.</p>
<p>N-3-1 SAI/DAI Instructor Leadership</p>	<p>Awarded annually to one cadet per LET level who displays the highest degree of leadership throughout the school year.</p>
<p>N-3-2 Personal Appearance</p>	<p>Awarded annually to cadets who consistently present an outstanding appearance (based on Uniform Inspection Grades) .</p>

<p>N-3-3 Proficiency</p>	<p>Awarded annually to those cadets who have demonstrated an exceptionally high degree of leadership, academic achievement, and performance of duty.</p> <p>(Ex: A cadet who has earned the personal appearance ribbon, the good conduct ribbon, and maintained a "B" average or higher in JROTC would be a candidate for this award)</p>
<p>N-3-4 Drill Team</p>	<p>Awarded annually to Drill Team members who have participated in at least 3 drill competitions.</p>
<p>N-3-5 Orienteering</p>	<p>Awarded annually to cadets who are members of orienteering teams. (Ex: Cadets who have successfully completed land navigation at JCLC)</p>
<p>N-3-6 Color Guard/ Honor Guard</p>	<p>Awarded annually to members of the Color/Honor Guards. (Must have been part of at least 3 Color Guard/Honor Guard events)</p>
<p>N-3-7 Rifle Team</p>	<p>Awarded annually to members of the Rifle Team who have competed in at least 2 marksmanship competitions.</p>
<p>N-3-8 Adventure Team Ribbon</p>	<p>Awarded annually to cadets who are members of adventure training units. (Cadets who have participated on the adventure team at JCLC)</p>

<p>N-3-9 Commendation</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets whose performance of duty exceptionally exceeds that expected for their grade and experience.</p> <p>(Ex: A cadet who has earned the proficiency ribbon and has maintained an "A" average in JROTC as well as the ability to perform duties exceptionally when designated by the instructors would be a candidate for this award)</p>
<p>N-3-10 Good Conduct Ribbon/Cadet of the Month</p>	<p>Awarded annually to the cadets who have demonstrated outstanding conduct and participation.</p> <p>(Ex: A cadet who has won a Cadet of the Month board one of the given months out of the school year, would be a candidate for this award)</p>
<p>N-3-11 JCLC</p>	<p>Awarded to those cadets who have participated in JROTC JCLC summer camp.</p>
<p>N-3-12 Most Improved</p>	<p>Awarded annually to a cadet who has demonstrated much growth over the school year and has put fourth recognizable effort into excelling throughout the program.</p>
<p>N-3-13 Battalion Formal Inspection</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets that have participated in the Battalion <u>Formal</u> Inspection</p> <p>(Ex: Staff, Service-Learning Briefing, Portfolio Inspection)</p>
<p>N-3-14 Spirit Award</p>	<p>Awarded annually to cadets who show dedication and motivation towards the program.</p>
<p>N-3-15 Fundraising Ribbon</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets that have participated in at least 3 Battalion Fundraising Events.</p>

<p>N-4-1 Parade</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets who have participated in local community parades with JROTC.</p> <p>(Ex: Veterans or Memorial Day parades)</p>
<p>N-4-2 Recruiting</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets who recruit at least 2 students into the JROTC program.</p>
<p>N-4-3 Flag Detail</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets who have participated in Flag Detail for a semester (2 quarters).</p>
<p>N-4-4 Service Hours</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets who have 100 service hours or more accredited in Virtual Counselor.</p>
<p>N-4-5 Honor Company</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets who are members of the company that has won Honor Company the most months out of the school year.</p>
<p>N-4-6 Service Learning</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets who have participated in the Service-Learning project.</p>
<p>N-4-7 Excellent Staff Performance</p>	<p>Awarded to cadets on Staff who have shown excellent performance throughout the school year.</p>
<p>White Color/ Honor Guard Cord</p>	<p>Awarded annually to members of the Color/Honor Guards. (Must have been part of at least 5 Color Guard/Honor Guard events and have passed Color/Honor Guard Test)</p>
<p>Red Drill Cord</p>	<p>Awarded annually to Drill Team members who have participated on the Drill Team for <u>two</u> years/seasons. (participate in at least 6 Drill competitions)</p>

Black Raider Cord	Awarded annually to cadets who have participated in at least one Raiders season (3 competitions)
Tan Marksmanship Cord	Awarded annually to cadets who have participated in at least one Marksmanship season (3 competitions)
Green Flag Detail cord	Awarded to the <u>current</u> Flag Detail Commander (only <u>one</u> cadet will be allowed to wear this cord per school year/cord must be returned when cadet retires from position)
Blue Marching Band Cord	Awarded to cadets who have participated in the Western High School Marching Band.
Honor Unit Star Wreath	Cadet must be in the top 10% of their JROTC class.
Flag Detail Arc	Be part of Flag Detail for the entire year (2 semesters/4 quarters).
Raiders Arc	Participate in at least 2 Raider seasons.
Regulation (Drill Team) Arc	Participate in at least 1 Drill season.
Color Guard Arc	Be part a Color Guard/Honor Guard for 4 events.
Staff Arc	Must be a Battalion Staff Officer.
JCLC Arc	Must have attended and completed JCLC summer camp.
Bronze Lamp	Issued the 2 nd time an award has been earned
Silver Lamp	Issued the 3 rd time an award has been earned

Gold Lamp	Issued the 4th time an award has been earned
